SCRIPTURE LESSON

1 CORINTHIANS 11: 23-26

23 FOR I RECEIVED FROM THE LORD THAT WHICH I ALSO DELIVERED TO YOU: THAT THE LORD JESUS ON THE SAME NIGHT IN WHICH HE WAS BETRAYED TOOK BREAD;

24 AND WHEN HE HAD GIVEN THANKS, HE BROKE IT AND SAID, "TAKE, EAT; THIS IS MY BODY WHICH IS BROKEN FOR YOU; DO THIS IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME."

25 IN THE SAME MANNER HE ALSO TOOK THE CUP AFTER SUPPER, SAYING, "THIS CUP IS THE NEW COVENANT IN MY BLOOD. THIS DO, AS OFTEN AS YOU DRINK IT, IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME."

The Roman Road

The first part of the Romans Road confirms the state of every human as sinful and the state of God as holy. *"As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one;" Romans 3:10. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," Romans 3:23.*

Jethro and Moses

We strengthen our relationships as we help one another walk wisely and in step with Christ. As the body of Christ, we are to support one another in being the men and women of God we are called to be. Every follower of Christ is called on to mentor or disciple others, helping them grow in wisdom and maturity. After observing and listening to Moses, Jethro offered his advice. Jethro said Moses' essential task was to *"Teach them ordinances and laws, and shalt shew them the way wherein they must walk, and the work that they must do."* Moses profited from a mentoring relationship with Jethro in the early years of the journey out of Egypt.

Mentors should lead others to understand the "way to live" that will please and honor God. Also, a good mentoring relationship should focus on not simply identifying problems, but on discovering solutions. For those who are being mentored, Moses modeled a critical component: a teachable spirit. As you consider entering a mentoring relationship, look for these traits and seek to develop these traits. Only then can the relationship be fruitful.
